It's so kind of them to help sick people feel better, don't you think?

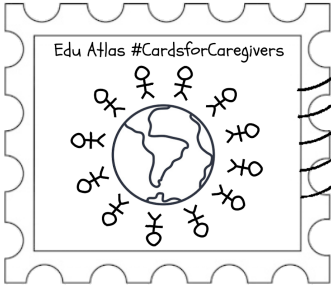
Since they are so kind and brave, we should show them that we are thankful for them.
